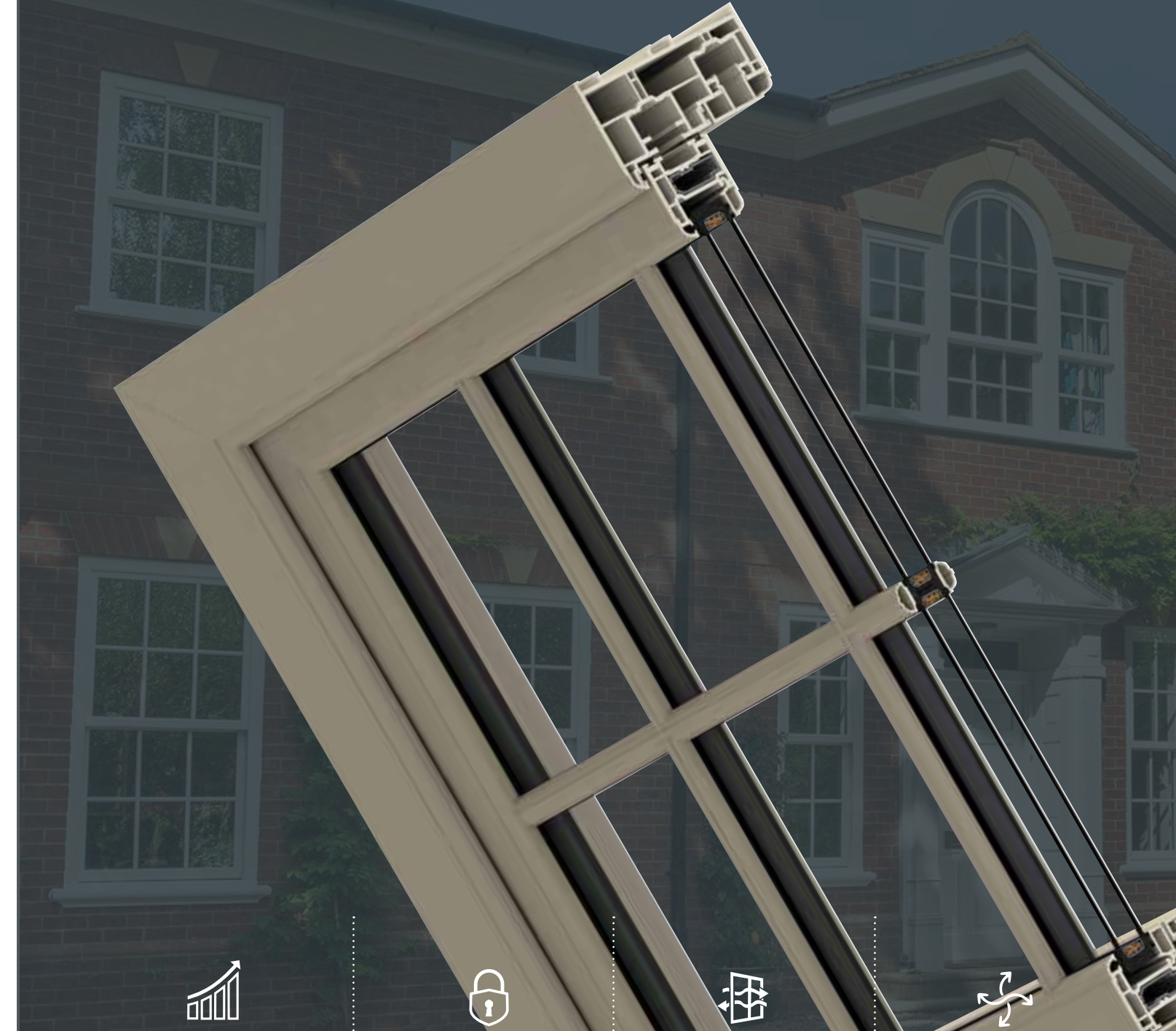

All the details you need are available. Run-through or moulded sash horns, Georgian bars, dedicated ancillaries, end caps and cills. The system takes off-the-shelf and high-security hardware and is available in a wealth of colour options too.

Impressive performance

The window benefits from 24mm double glazing as standard. Woolpile weather seals are fitted around the outer frame and sashes, and there's an optional weatherbar which can improve weather performance and enhance the overall appearance. For improved thermal efficiency there are optional thermal inserts for the sashes, made from recycled composite materials. A WER of A+ and U-values as low as 1.3 W/m²K can be achieved.

Valuable practicality

The sashes tilt inwards for easy cleaning and use reliable spiral balance mechanisms for easy operation. The system can accommodate trickle or glazed-in vents and feature travel stops for child safety. The maximum size is up to 1600mm wide and 2400mm high.
